### Wednesday Campfires:

## BOYS & GIRLS CLUB OF PAWTUCKET

### Registrations:

- Monday-Saturday at the Boys & Girls Club of Pawtucket (Starting in February)
- Saturdays in May & June at Camp Ramsbottom (10 a.m. to 2 p.m.)
- Registrations are accepted by mail.
- All forms may also be printed from our website at: [www.bgcpawt.org](http://www.bgcpawt.org).

### Camp Fees:

- \$260 per session (*lunch available for an additional fee of \$25 per session*).
- A Boys & Girls Club of Pawtucket \$30 membership is also required.
- **Refund (minus deposits) granted only if camp office is notified in writing 14 days before session starts. Notify camp if not attending.**
- The first session a child attends during the summer must be paid in full at time of registration.
- A \$75 non-refundable & non-transferable deposit per session will guarantee each reservation.
- Special group assignments must be noted at time of registration.
- Balance due 2 weeks prior to the start of the session.
- Registrations for camp sessions will not be accepted until back balances on any and all Club programs have been paid.



## CAMP RAMSBOTTOM

### Scholarships:

Families meeting established income guidelines are eligible for one free session for each child who attends Camp Ramsbottom. Those applying for scholarships must fill out a separate form and provide proof of income. Availability is limited.

### Extended Care:

- 7:30 a.m. – 5:30 p.m.
- \$80 additional per session
- \$40 deposit required per session
- Space is limited!

### Additional Procedures and Policies:

- Parents may obtain a summation of our procedure for background checks of staff as well as copies of our medical and discipline policies. Grievance forms are also available through both offices.
- The Director reserves the right to dismiss a camper when the camper's behavior interferes with the rights of others or when such behavior disrupts the operation of the group, activity or the camp in general.
- Parents are reminded that **ALL** activities are conducted outdoors. All program areas have canopies but **NONE** are indoors. Should you decide to send your child(ren) on an inclement weather day, please provide appropriate raingear (galoshes, coat/poncho, hat, etc.).
- Non-campers may enter campgrounds only when escorted by a member of the camp staff. Visitors must report directly to the Office to register. Visitors must leave a driver's license and car keys at the Office while on the campgrounds.



## BOYS & GIRLS CLUB OF PAWTUCKET

### Arrival and Dismissal from Camp:

- Drop-off campers between 8:00 and 8:45 a.m. to avoid the congestion caused by Camp buses.
- Campers arriving late must sign in at the office with an accompanying adult.
- Pick-up time is between 4:05 and 4:45 p.m. This will allow buses to leave Camp at 4:00 p.m.
- Parents requesting early dismissal must send a note to the office. A phone call follow-up is also recommended.
- We recommend that early dismissals be scheduled between 12:30 and 1:30 p.m. However, the early pick-up time must be before 3:00 p.m.

### Transportation:

Bus stops are conveniently located throughout nearby Rhode Island and Southeastern Massachusetts — see application for bus stop locations (page 9). Camp Ramsbottom will provide supervision on every bus but NOT at every bus stop. Parents/Guardians are expected to supervise their children until they board the bus and must be at the bus stop when they return from camp. Campers must arrive and return home on the same bus. Campers must also arrive and depart from Camp by the same transportation method.



*Camp Ramsbottom complies with regulations of the Massachusetts Department of Health and is licensed by the Rehoboth Board of Health.*

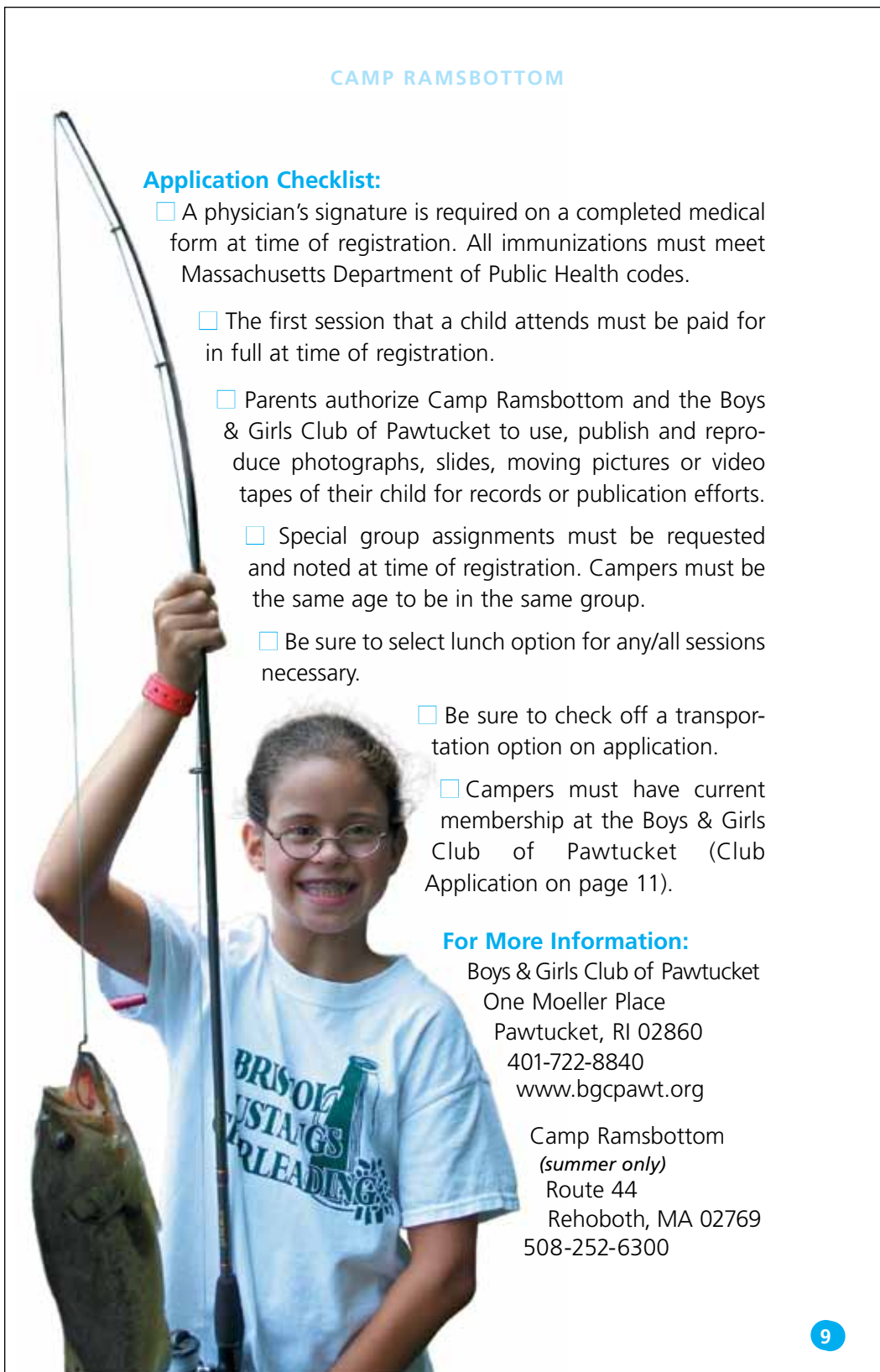
### Application Checklist:

- A physician's signature is required on a completed medical form at time of registration. All immunizations must meet Massachusetts Department of Public Health codes.
- The first session that a child attends must be paid for in full at time of registration.
- Parents authorize Camp Ramsbottom and the Boys & Girls Club of Pawtucket to use, publish and reproduce photographs, slides, moving pictures or video tapes of their child for records or publication efforts.
- Special group assignments must be requested and noted at time of registration. Campers must be the same age to be in the same group.
- Be sure to select lunch option for any/all sessions necessary.
- Be sure to check off a transportation option on application.
- Campers must have current membership at the Boys & Girls Club of Pawtucket (Club Application on page 11).
