### Camp Fees:

- \$170 per session (\$150 per session for the second child; \$140 for the third child – discount does not apply to extended care).
- A Boys & Girls Club of Pawtucket \$30 membership is required.
- Refund (minus deposits) granted only if office is notified in writing 14 days in advance of session start. Notify Boys & Girls Club of Pawtucket if not attending.
- The first session a child attends during the summer must be paid in full at time of registration.
- A \$75 non-refundable & non-transferable deposit per session will guarantee each reservation.
- Balance due 2 weeks prior to the start of the session.
- The Boys & Girls Club charges a \$10 per half hour late fee for all children dropped off before the start of camp and not picked up on time at the end of camp.
- Registrations for camp sessions will not be accepted until back balances on any and all Club programs have been paid.

### Scholarships:

Beginning in May, a limited number of scholarships will be available for families meeting the established income guidelines. Apply for scholarships at the front desk of the Elson Clubhouse. Proof of income is required at time of registration.

### Arrival & Dismissal from Camp:

- Your camper will need to be signed in and out of Camp with his/her counselor on a daily basis. Identification must be presented to the counselor at the time of pick-up.
- Drop-off at 8:30 a.m. Please park your car and walk your camper to the field. All campers must be accompanied by an adult. Campers will only meet inside the building in cases of extreme weather.
- Pick-up by 4:15 p.m. in the field.
- If your child is allowed to walk home, the Camp Director must be provided with a written, signed note from a parent/guardian.

### Additional Procedures and Policies:

- Campers who wish to participate in kayaking need to have a separate permission slip signed by a parent or guardian in order to participate. Forms will be provided to members who pass the Club's swim test (offered at the start of each session).
- The Boys & Girls Club enforces a policy of zero tolerance for disruptive behavior, physical aggression, violence of any sort, inappropriate language or the disrespect of others or their property. These behaviors will not be tolerated and the Camp Director may dismiss a camper from the program. Refunds will not be given for dismissals due to inappropriate behavior.
- Special group assignments must be requested at time of registration. Campers must be the same age to be in the same group.
- Camp Sun 'n' Fun is open rain or shine!

## CAMP SUN 'n' FUN

### Application Checklist:

- A physician's signature is required on a completed medical form at time of registration. All immunizations must meet Rhode Island Department of Public Health codes.
- The first session a child attends must be paid for in full at time of registration.
- Parent/Guardian authorizes the Boys & Girls Club of Pawtucket to use, publish and reproduce photographs, slides, moving pictures or video tapes of their child for its records or publication efforts.
- Special group assignments must be requested and noted at time of registration. Campers must be the same age to be in the same group.
- Campers must have a current membership at the Boys & Girls Club of Pawtucket.
